Revised Spring Wheat Falling Numbers Fall 2026:

Due to the deteriorating condition of the spring wheat particularly for falling numbers. Any spring wheat harvested after 9/8/26, Border Ag requests a sample before we will be dumping loads. We need to be able to keep our qualities segregated on this crop. We will also be waiting till samples have been tested and graded before settling spring wheat. We will be reviewing the discount schedules as well to see if they reflect the current market conditions. 199 falling numbers and below will automatically be graded as feed wheat and be valued as such (No delayed price). If it needs to be applied to a contract the contract value will be adjusted to reflect feed wheat values.

We understand the frustration that may come with this, but we need to be able to segregate and bin the qualities accordingly. We also may have limited space depending on the location and quantity for the spring wheat.
